This year our class will be using a colored clip chart to monitor our behavior and classroom choices. Your child will have a clip that they will physically move up or down on a chart depending on their choices. Every child starts on green everyday and may not move up or down on any given day. In order to move up the clip chart, your child will need to go above and beyond our classroom behavior expectations. This chart will explain how the clip chart works.

Olf Olivel Collex	
Carly Ionch Itisi	Students who reach the pink level will be awarded for their excellent choices.
PURPLE LOOking Sharp!	Students who continue to make excellent choices and reach the purple level will be one step closer to being a super student.
BLUE Stick With It!	Students who make excellent choices will be recognized in the classroom by moving up to the blue level.
GREEN Ready to learn	Everyday all students begin on the green level and can move their clip up for good choices or down for poor choices.
YELOW Acting Thorny!	Students who receive a warning for their behavior they move their card down to the yellow level. This is a reminder to make better choices.
ORANGE Pretty Prickly!	Students who continue to make poor choices will move their card down to the orange level. At this level students will receive a consequence.
RED Ouch!	Students who reach the red level will receive either a note or a call home and an additional consequence.

I believe this clip chart system will be a positive way for students to monitor their behavior and choices as well as give them goals to strive for. If you have any questions feel free to contact me.
