Listed are the behavioral procedures that your student will be expected to adhere to this school year. Please review the procedures listed with your student. We have reviewed the material with the students today at school.

Behavioral Procedures

(Steps may be skipped if deemed necessary.)

- 1. Verbal warning
- 2. Last chance warning (present punch card)
- 3. Punch on card
- 4. Chill Out & 2nd Punch
- 5. Office Referral

Punches 1-3	Warning
Punches 4-6	Parent Notification
Punches 7-9	1/2 Day ISS
Punches 10-12	1 Day ISS
Punches over 12	OSS or Alternative Placement

Agendas and Punch Cards

Agendas will be issued to each student on the first day of school. Each student will need to keep up with and take care of their agenda. Students are required to use them each day to record assignments. New punch cards will be issued to the students each nine weeks. Students will be required to keep their punch card in their lanyards. It is imperative that student agendas and punch cards remain with them at all times. Punch cards may only be reissued by the homeroom teacher and will be issued with an additional punch for the lost card. Number of punches and offenses will be recorded in Educator's Handbook.

Incentives and Field Trips

Each nine weeks, the students will be rewarded for their good behavior and academic achievement with an incentive. In order for a student to qualify for these incentives, he/she must have no more than 6 punches on their punch card that nine weeks, no grades lower than a 70, and no office referrals (ISS or OSS) for the grading period. Once a new nine weeks begins, students will have the ability to work towards the next incentive.

The 7th grade will also have academic field trips such as Wonder Works in Myrtle Beach. More information will be sent out about this in the coming weeks.
