 Math and manipulative gives the opportunity for children to improve their coordination, learn about counting and sorting, and expand their problemsolving skills










# SCIENCE

- It can also provide children with a quiet place to learn













#### CREATIVE CURRICULUM

  - Getting Ready for Kindergarten












#### TEACHING STRATEGIES GOLD

#### TEACHING STRATEGIES


 TS Gold is the online assessment system that we use to track the progress of the students in our class

- 10. Uses appropriate conversational and other communication skills






# COGNITIVE


- 15. Demonstrates phonological awareness, phonics skills, and word recognition

#### SOCIAL EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Second Step and Conscious Discipline are researched based, teacher informed, and classroom tested to promote the social emotional development safety and well being of children
  - This helps them listen, pay attention, self regulate, manage their behavior and get along with others
- We also focus on problem solving skills as well
  - Ex: Sharing, turn-taking, decision-making
