

Here is a list of items we could use in the Art Room.

It is mostly a “things we’re already getting rid of” list.

If you send something in with your child, please remind them to drop off their donation in the morning before school/class or during their art class.

The items in bold or large are particularly desired. Please wash and rinse recyclables!

- rectangular plastic containers (Lids or not)
- **rectangular** gallon ice cream containers
- Plastic Sara Lee rectangular Deli containers
- Applesauce, Orange plastic meow mix containers
- Plastic gerber baby food jars AND lids (either/both)
- **Small plastic containers (ex: yogurt cups, etc...)**
- **Baby wipe containers**
- Yogurt cups that stack (no non-stacking, please!)
- Old paint rollers
- **Bubble wrap**
- Tissue paper
- **Paper bags, folded**
- Disposable plates, any kind
- **Small wood scraps**
- **Buttons**
- **Beads**
- Ribbon, yarn
- Drawing supplies (markers, colored pencils, pastels, etc...)
- **Permanent markers/Sharpies, black or colors**
- Beads
- 1 Ironing board
- old coffee table art books
- **EGG CARTONS, especially cardboard**
- **Small cardboard boxes (about 6” max, empty gift/jewelry boxes, etc...)**
- **Thin “cereal box” type cardboard.**
(Please, no empty kleenex/tissue boxes at this time.)
- Pipe Cleaners
- Small tubes
- Old, washed t-shirts (holey is fine)
- Paper of all kinds (cardstock, construction, scrapbook, poster board, etc...)
- Styrofoam packing material (peanuts or random shapes)
- **Unused craft items**
- old/scratched CDs
- **Wallpaper sample books**
- **Plexiglas (any sizes, scraps too)**
- sea shells
- old costume jewelry
- old kitchen utensils
- *“interesting junk”*; Still life stuff - (email if you have a question):”, small toys (cars, vehicles, plastic animals, etc...), saucers, cups, bottles, glasses, “old stuff”
- old animal/wildlife/outdoor books or animal magazines or calendars
- **Plastic animal models, realistic preferred**
- **“how to” art books for our classroom library**
- **Muffin tins**
- **Block sets (lego, foam blocks, tinker toys, etc)**
- **safety pins**
- magnets
- canvas/tarps, new, worn, torn
