

## 12th Grade—College & Career Training

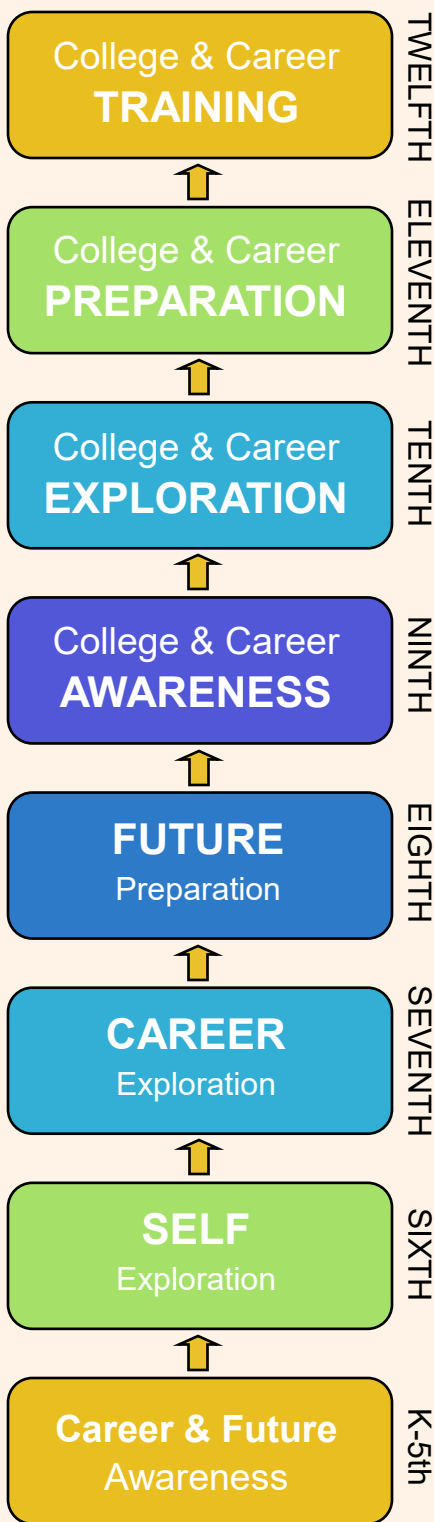
### Learning for Future Planning

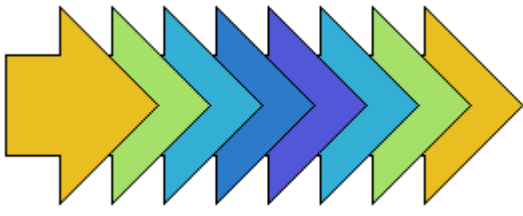
