Onslow County high school teachers are invited to nominate students for this grant. Please note that these programs require appropriate placement criteria for admission.

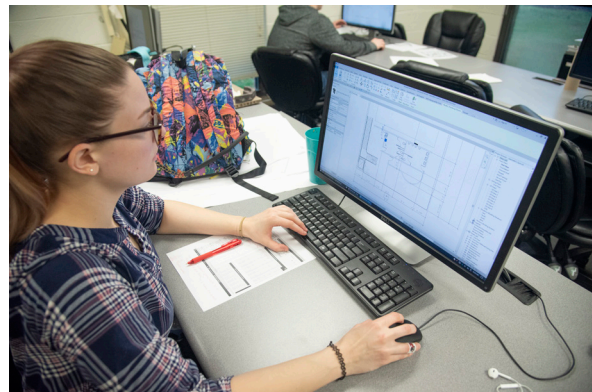
Students applying for the Industrial Technology Grant must complete the following steps:

- Complete your residency application through the North Carolina Residency Determination Service (RDS)
- Complete a Coastal Carolina Community College application for admissions
- Have a cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.5 from high school
- Complete the grant application located on the back of this form
- Attach current (unofficial) HS transcript; request official, final transcript to be submitted to CCCC
- Attach required essay to this application (essay requirement on other side)
- Submit this Grant Application and all required documents to your high school's College Liaison
- Complete the FAFSA- Even if you do not qualify for federal financial aid, you must submit an updated FAFSA each year at fafsa.gov in order for your scholarship application to be considered complete.
