

Onslow County Local Summer School

Overview

The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction [with plans approved by the local Board of Education] has allowed school districts the opportunity to provide its' students a local summer school option. The purpose of the summer school is to provide students "an additional learning opportunity that occurs outside of the regular academic calendar."

We are excited to announce the Onslow County Board of Education, in accordance with state education policies, has approved a plan which will allow students to participate in a summer school option for the 2023-2024 school year. The purpose of this local summer school is to provide students an opportunity to increase academic skills and possibly recover credit through a focused summer remediation session.

Times and Locations

Summer School will be held from **June 18-20 and June 24-25, 2024**. Each campus will participate in this opportunity. Sessions will last 3 1/2 hours per day beginning approximately at 8:30 for elementary sites and 9:00 for middle and high school sites.

Subjects of Focus

- English/Language Arts - grades 4-8, English II
- Math - grades 3-8, Math 1, Math 3
- Science - grades 5 and 8, Biology

Selection of Students

Selection for the Onslow County Local Summer School will be based on all available academic information as well as results from the state assessments. Personal phone calls will be made to families regarding this opportunity.
