homework

Until an assignment is turned in, a zero will be put in the gradebook. This zero is not permanent, work can STILL be turned in with a grace period. However, you will only have 5 days to turn it in.



policy for absences & grades

Work will be updated each day on Teams or One Note. Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you may have about grades.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work (one day for make-up for each day absent).

All make-up work will be placed in your classes absent folder and your name will be written on any work you missed. It is your responsibility to ask a classmate or me for help on making up any assignments or checking One Note regularly to complete the work.

If you know you are going to be absent beforehand, you should ask me for your make-up work before the absence.

electronic devices
