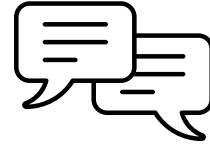

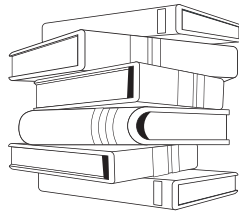
Students enrolled in this course will earn High School credit upon successful completion of the course. This course is intended to be rigorous & challenging as we dig into the impact of the past on our lives today.

World History 9 is intended to examine the historical development of the world and global issues and patterns since 1500. The goal of this course is to blend the historical with the contemporary and current so that students begin to acquire an understanding of how the historical events and decisions of ancient, classical, and modern history have implications or lasting impacts that have influenced the world in which we currently live.

EXPECTATIONS

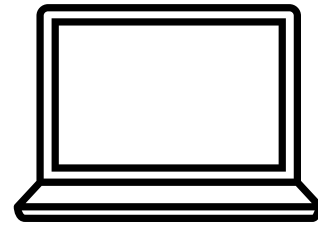
- Students will respect themselves, classmates, the virtual & physical classroom, and the teacher.

We will be completing many projects this year & some work may need to be done outside of classes to finish the project or find materials for the project.

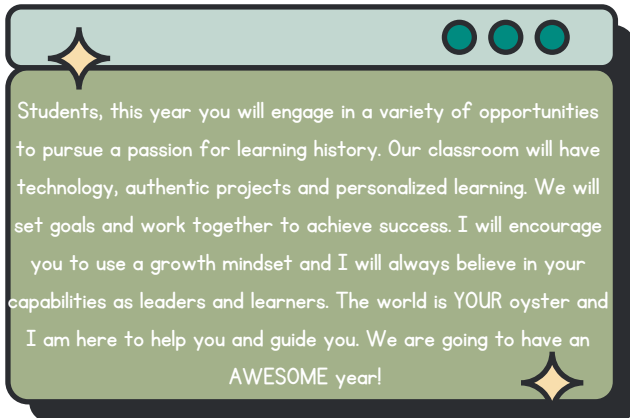


DEVICES
