Dear Potential SAT Scholar and Family,

Congratulations on your academic achievement this past year. The SAT Board of Directors would like to inform you of the opportunity that you have to earn the SAT Scholarship when you graduate.

SAT, Inc. is dedicated to providing scholarships to students in the Onslow County Schools. To qualify, **all students** must meet the following three criteria:

1. Maintain a 3.0 GPA on the weighted scale
2. Score 1100 (composite of verbal and mathematics) on the SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) or a combined score of 23 on the ACT.
3. Attain a College Preparatory Diploma
 - a. 4 English
 - b. 4 Mathematics
 - c. 3 Science
 - d. 3 Social Studies
 - e. 2 Foreign Language

To obtain a **\$500.00 Scholarship**, you must also:

1. Perform a minimum of 75 hours of community service
2. Complete 20 hours in the senior year (first day of summer break)
3. Perform a maximum of 35 church and school hours
4. Perform a minimum of 40 hours at approved agencies (back of page)

To obtain a **\$1,000.00 Scholarship**, you must also:

1. Complete 20 hours in the senior year (first day of summer break)
2. Perform a minimum of 100 hours at approved agencies

The SAT Board of Directors would like to remind you that in order to receive the SAT Scholarship, you **must** adhere to the following regulations:

1. No SAT hours may be earned during the school day (7:30-2:30)
2. A maximum of 4 hours may be performed on a school day
3. A maximum of 8 hours may be performed on a non-school day
4. No hours may be performed on the military base or air station
5. Hours performed at non approved agencies will not be counted

Hours are to be submitted to your SAT Coordinator 5 days upon completion or at a minimum at the beginning of the school year and the beginning of spring semester.
