Rolling Thunder®, Inc. NC-5 will be awarding scholarships to qualified applicants. Scholarships will be awarded for academic excellence and merit. To qualify, the applicant must be a Legacy of a current/ active member of Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter NC-5; or must be a military family member with a valid I.D. card. An applicant cannot have been a former recipient of this scholarship. Additionally, the applicant’s sponsor must meet one of the following criteria:

1. Active duty military personnel serving in Onslow, Carteret, or Craven County
2. Active duty personnel currently fulfilling an unaccompanied PCS tour whose last duty station was in Onslow, Carteret, or Craven County.
3. Retired or deceased military personnel whose last duty station was in Onslow, Carteret or Craven County.
4. Be a current/active member of Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter NC-5.

Scholarships will be awarded to full time and/or part time students who will attend an accredited and or licensed trade or technical school, two - year, four - year degree institution. The candidate must have a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale. The recipient should also be of good moral character with a proven record of community service.

All qualified applicants will be considered provided they have properly completed the application procedure. Information must be complete, and all supporting documents must be attached. Selection of recipients will be made by Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter NC-5's selection committee and their Board of Directors. The Board’s decision will be final.

Scholarships are awarded for the upcoming academic year and must be used for tuition, academic fees, and books only. Students who receive other scholarships and/or grants equal to or greater than the first year’s tuition, academic fees and books will forfeit their Rolling Thunder®, Inc. Chapter NC-5 Scholarship and an alternate recipient will then be awarded the scholarship. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the college or university in the student’s name.
