Scholarships

The Jacksonville Rotary Club will award **five** scholarships in the amount of **\$2,000 each in 2024**. Scholarships will be made payable to the student's accredited vocational school, community college, or four-year College or university. Prior to Scholarship Payment, scholarship awardees must have acceptance from an accredited vocational school, community college, or four-year college or university sent to Ashleymariehayes@gmail.com --- acceptance letter is not required for application, but will be required for payment.

Timeline of Events

- **January 15, 2024:** Applications available to students
- **April 19, 2024:** Applications due by 11:59 pm
- **Late April 2024:** Required interviews for selected scholarship candidates
- **May 6, 2024:** Scholarship recipients notified
- **May 14, 2024:** Scholarship recipients, parents, principal and counselor invited to Rotary Meeting at 12:00 pm.

Eligibility

Graduating seniors from Eastern NC Regional Skills Center, Jacksonville High, Lejeune High, Northside High, Onslow Early College, Onslow Virtual, Southwest High, and White Oak High, as well as Home and Private School students that live in the above school districts are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Applications submitted by ineligible applicants will not be considered under any circumstances. Scholarship applicants must have acceptance from an accredited vocational school, community college, or four-year college or university by **April 19, 2024**.

Prior to receiving funding, a scholarship recipient must submit the acceptance letter and proof of enrollment to any accredited vocational school, community college or four-year college or university.

Criteria for Selection of Scholarship Applicants

Applicants will be evaluated in three areas, each weighed equally in the selection process:

1/3 Financial need

1/3 Academic achievement – high school transcript, SAT or ACT scores, grade point average, and class rank

1/3 Other considerations – extracurricular activities, unusual circumstances, goals and aspirations, etc.

Applicant Selection

Finalists will be selected based on information provided in this application and will be interviewed by the Rotary Scholarship Committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified personally.

Applicant Instructions

1) Complete the entire application via the online form at <https://forms.gle/8Fm9UntgapNYD9hi6> to include sending **three** Applicant Appraisal forms. High school counselors, course instructors, and work supervisors are eligible to complete Applicant Appraisals. 2) Acquire a current official transcript from your guidance department. Online transcripts and grade reports are not acceptable. **Send to Ashleymariehayes@gmail.com no later than April 19, 2024.**

3) Submit Online Form, Appraisal Forms and Official Transcript no later than **April 19, 2024.**

Please note that all materials must be submitted by the application deadline. Incomplete packages cannot be considered. Do not submit application packages via mail.
