4. Proof of your enrollment to a 4-year Institute for 2022-2023 school year.
5. Include an essay of no more than 500 words using the explanation of what PRETTY Girls Rock stands for, explaining how YOU demonstrate being a PRETTY Girl.
6. Feel free to include any other information you think is important and should be considered in your application.

Requirements for College Students Applicants (Undergraduate):

1. Proof of Enrollment /letter from Registrar's Office/record of performance (grades)
2. At least one letter of recommendation.
3. Include an essay of no more than 500 words using the explanation of what PRETTY Girls Rock stands for, explaining how YOU demonstrate being a PRETTY Girl.
4. Feel free to include any other information you think is important and should be considered in your application.
